Nassau-Suffolk Hospital Council has a <u>NEW</u> application assistance program for the <u>aged, certified blind</u>, <u>and certified disabled populations</u>. It has partnered with Suffolk County Department of Social Services in a grant with the NYS Department of Health to target these special populations in Nassau and Suffolk counties. These sites are <u>different from the Navigator program</u>, which helps people apply for Medicaid based on MAGI rules through the online NY State of Health insurance marketplace. <u>This program is</u> <u>designed to help those who are eligible for Medicaid based on non-MAGI rules complete the paper</u> <u>Access NY and Supplemental A applications that are submitted directly to the local districts</u>
